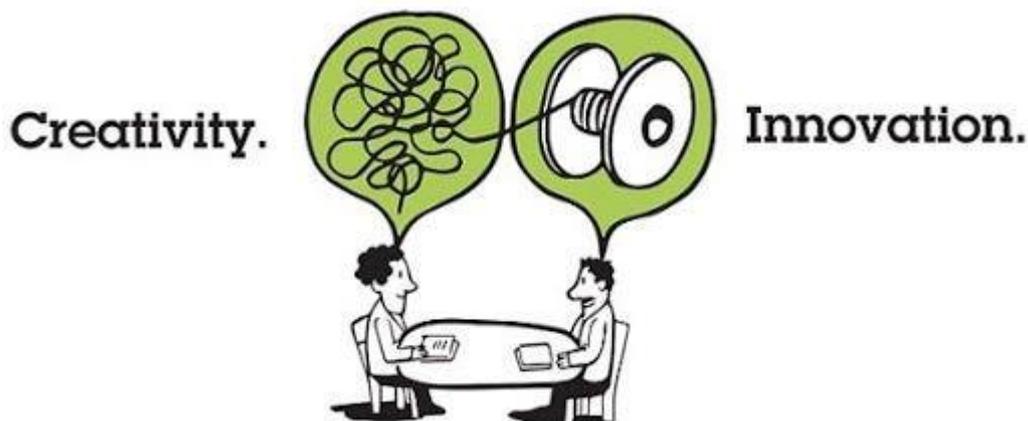


Creativity and Innovation
